


What our Network does

Action Network

Action Network is a nonprofit serving southern Mendocino and northern Sonoma Counties. Services include a full range for ages 0-18 including playgroups, school readiness (preschool), Music Together, tutoring, Triple P Positive Parenting, CalFresh, behavioral health support, family advocacy, citizenship preparation support, peer and professional counseling, career counseling program, summer enrichment programs, multi-cultural celebrations and more.



Willits & Ukiah Family Centers

Mendocino County's Health & Human Services Agency Family Centers offer supportive classes and services such as: Family Empowerment Groups, Triple P classes, Partner Relationship Classes, Personal Coping Strategies, Supervised Court Ordered Visitation. Services offered in Spanish and English. Centers located in Ukiah and Willits.

The Arbor

The Arbor Youth Resource Center is a welcoming place that offers a range of services, activities, and opportunities that respond to the needs and hopes of youth (ages 15-24) in our community. We offer resources to achieve their career, education and personal goals. The Arbor provides a safe and positive environment with workshops and classes to help youth feel confident and empowered.



Laytonville Healthy Start

Laytonville Healthy Start Family Resource Center was established in 1997 to provide services & supports to our small, rural community. Today, our FRC serves over 1,000 people annually in a variety of programs and services such as: Medi-Cal/Covered CA insurance sign ups, CalFresh application assistance, after-school programs, clothing closet, playgroup, parenting support, mental health counseling and referrals.



Nuestra Alianza

Nuestra Alianza specializes in education and services for the entire Willits Latino community and anyone else who would care to join us. As soon as a need is identified, we mobilize to meet it.



Round Valley FRC

Our vision is to connect families in the community of Round Valley to existing service providers, and all resources that promote the physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual well being of all families. We offer FIRST 5 Mendocino-Diaper Depot, Imagination Library, Positive Parenting Program, Medi-Cal & Cal-Fresh Program application assistance, computer use for students/community, Educational Tutoring on site or at Round Valley Unified School District.



Potter Valley FRC


