

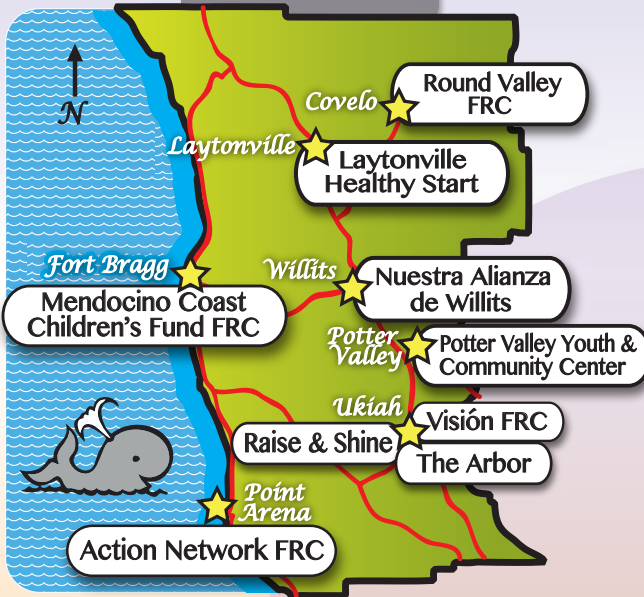

We offer FIRST 5 Mendocino Diaper Depot, Imagination Library, Positive Parenting Program, Medi-Cal & Cal-Fresh Program application assistance, public computers, Educational Tutoring on site or at Round Valley Unified School District.

We offer referrals and services like CalFresh application assistance, internet, faxing & printing access, parent support, play groups for ages 0-5, Preschool Enrichment program, and much more!



The Arbor

Our center is a welcoming place that offers a range of services, activities, and opportunities that respond to the needs and hopes of youth (ages 15-24) in our community. We offer resources for youth to achieve their career, education and personal goals. The Arbor provides a safe and positive environment with workshops and classes to help youth feel confident and empowered.

Action Network's services include age 0-5 playgroups, school readiness, Positive Parenting training, environmental stewardship, Teen Group, behavioral health support, Social Emotional Learning and Coaching, peer and professional counseling, food security, mental health support, intersession enrichment learning opportunities for TK-12th grades, community events and more.



Laytonville Healthy Start

Providing services & programs to our rural community, we serve over 1,000 people annually in a variety of programs and services such as: Food Bank, Medi-Cal insurance sign ups, CalFresh application assistance, holiday meals & toy drive, parenting support, clothing closet for kids & adults, mental health counseling & referrals and more!

Our Alliance specializes in education and services for all Willits Latino community and anyone else who would like to join us. As soon as we identify a need, we mobilize to meet it.



Visión Family Resource Center

Bilingual services to local families include: Direct support (free diapers, shelf-stable food, etc.) Classes for parents and children, Application assistance (CalFresh, LIHEAP, CARE, housing, etc.) Application translation assistance (Spanish), Long-term case management for Medi-Cal recipients, referrals and resources, Community events and Public computer access.
