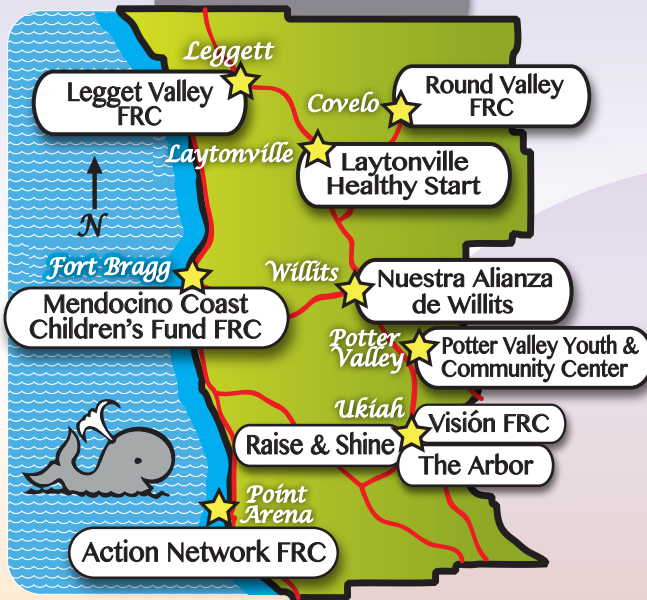


What our Network does

Potter Valley FRC

We offer referrals and services like CalFresh application assistance, internet, faxing & printing access, parent support, play groups for ages 0-5, Preschool Enrichment program, and much more!



Visión Family Resource Center

Bilingual services to local families include: Direct support (free diapers, shelf-stable food, etc.) Classes for parents and children, Application assistance (CalFresh, LIHEAP, CARE, housing, etc.) Application translation assistance (Spanish), Long-term case management for Medi-Cal recipients, referrals and resources, Community events and Public computer access.

Action Network's services include ages 0-5 playgroups, school readiness, Positive Parenting training, environmental stewardship, Teen Group, behavioral health support, Social Emotional Learning and Coaching, peer and professional counseling, food security, mental health support, intersession enrichment learning opportunities for TK-12th grades, community events and more.

Our Alliance specializes in education and services for all Willits Latino community and anyone else who would like to join us. As soon as we identify a need, we mobilize to meet it.



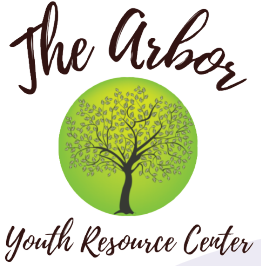
Mendocino Coast Childrens' Fund
